

## **Dance Fusion Covid-19 Rules and Regulations Summer 2021**

1. We will be operating from three venues this term- Newton Ferrers, Holberton and Elburton
2. If your child or a member of your family is experiencing symptoms of Coronavirus please do not send them. More information can be found on the NHS website.

2. Due to social distancing measures, class sizes are limited depending on the size of the hall. Our current max capacity for each venue per class is: Newton Ferrers- 12, Holbeton- 9 and Elburton- 9. Class bubbles are also still in effect for some classes, in which two or more classes may affect the size of another class where one student or more students does multiple classes. Acrobatic Arts is our current exception with bi-weekly attendance due to limited equipment and space.
3. All classes where a new set of children will be arriving will have a 15- minute cleaning slot in between. No students or parents should enter the building during this time. Classes which run back-to-back with the same students will run as normal.
4. There are to be no parents entering the building and children will be collected from the door and brought back out at the end of the lesson. Please only one parent to drop off and pick up. For this reason, children must arrive in their correct dance outfit and for those who cannot do shoes laces must arrive with their tap shoes already on. Please make sure they also have their own water bottle- as we do not currently have access to the kitchen areas at our venues and it is getting very hot this term.
5. All children must wear appropriate footwear for every class and cannot dance barefoot this includes older students who would normally wear foot thongs. Students are not allowed to dance in socks.
6. The children will be allocated their own 2m/sq space upon arrival, they will be required to remain in their square for the duration of the lesson except for going to the toilet and changing their shoes. There may be some exercises which can be danced from the corner and floor markers will be in place so that they line up and maintain their 2m distance.
7. If any parent must enter the building- in the case of an emergency or if a child is severely distressed, then a mask must be worn. All students over 11 years old are required to wear their mask when entering, leaving and moving around the room- including leaving to use the toilet.
8. Only one toilet in each building will be in operation. This will be clearly marked. A parent will be required to stay for young children who cannot use the toilet by themselves.
9. Hand Sanitiser will be available for use upon entry and exit from the building.
10. For those attending Acro if they have their own personal equipment e.g matts or blocks that they can bring with them this is recommended. I will have four matts available for use only.
13. The kitchen will be out of use at Newton Ferrers.
14. Pre-school children do not need to socially distance from each other but should be reminded that they should try to socially distance themselves from me- I know this will be very difficult.
15. Exam children only, will now receive hands on corrections if necessary- I will sanitise and wear my mask to do so. I will also sanitise and wear my mask if required to do up/undo shoelaces during a lesson.
